Rules and Regulations

(Complete TCPC rules may be viewed on the web and are available at the secretary's booth)

Proof of Rabies and Negative Coggins Required. They may be checked at any time.

The entry booth will open at 7:00 am, halter classes will close at 8:00 am. All other class entries will close 3 classes prior.

TCPC Rules and NYS Law requires 17 and under wear ASTM approved helmets.

Stallions and kickers must wear a red ribbon in their tail.

Juniors may not show stallions.

Assisted riding is for any rider 9 & Over that is not ready for walk/trot/jog. The rider must have a spotter, but may or may not have an actual lead attached. Entries will be asked to walk and trot or jog. May also be asked to halt and back.

Open W / T / J: Rider may only enter this division if the rider has not cantered at any competition or exhibition. This division is not for starter horses unless the rider also qualifies as a starter rider. Riders may not cross enter into any canter/lope classes.

Starter classes are for horses and ponies that do not canter and may not enter any canter classes at any competition or exhibition. Horses and ponies may enter this division for as long as they do not canter or lope at any competition or exhibition.

Lead line, Assisted and Anyone Can Ride classes are \$5 per class with no post entry fee.

Entry fees are \$8.00 per class. Pre-entries are encouraged. There will be a \$5.00 fee for post entries. Pre enter 1 class to save the post entry fee!

Classes must be paid for at time of entry or a blank check left with the secretary.

No refunds or substitution of classes.

Show managers reserve the right to split, combine and/or cancel any class based on # of entries or for any reason they feel warrants it.

There is a \$5 Office fee per horse.

Stalls are \$10.00 each whether used for a horse or as a tack stall.

Stalls must be cleaned before you leave. Pull all manure and bedding out in front of the stall and leave stall door closed.
